## **Research Analysis**

HB3252, as introduced, modifies the mission statement and duties of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) and the state's five-year economic development plan, which will be renamed the five-year infrastructure and community development plan. The measure removes ODOC as the state's official liaison agency for strategic economic development and business recruitment. Instead, ODOC will serve as a technical assistance resource for local communities seeking federal funding opportunities. ODOC is also directed to convene a working group of state agencies that includes ODOT, OWRB and the Oklahoma Broadband Office to maximize the investment of state and federal funds.
