Research Analysis

HB 3286 authorizes an Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education location contracted with Service Oklahoma to provide commercial driver training to issue commercial learner permits.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3286 allows the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education to contract with Service Oklahoma to issue commercial learner permits. According to the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, Two Thousand, Two Hundred and Fourteen individuals (2,214) passed the necessary exams for these commercial learner permits.

Under the assumption that all individuals would elect for an eight-year, Class A Commercial Learner permit (\$138.00 per permit), Service Oklahoma estimates an potential decrease of One Hundred Twenty-two Thousand, Two Hundred and Twelve dollars and Eighty cents (\$122,212.80) in Service Oklahoma & Licensed Operator Fee revenue. This is the revenue that is retained by the provider who processed the transaction, whether that be Service Oklahoma or a Licensed Operator.

Service Oklahoma estimates the implementation of this measure would cost Thirty-two Thousand, Three Hundred and Eighty-four dollars (\$32,384.00) to the agency.
