**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3304 allows a health benefit plan sponsor to consent to electronic communication on behalf of covered individuals enrolled in the plan. The insurer must inform the insured of the types of communications to be sent, how to withdraw consent, and the option to receive paper documents instead.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3304 allows a health insurance plan sponsor authority to authorize the transmission of plan-related communications electronically on behalf of the insured individual, assuming the insurer has already given notice to the insured individual regarding their right to withdraw consent at any time. As written, this measure does not have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
