**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3305 establishes the Oklahoma Ireland Trade Commission, which is to consist of nine members. The purpose of the Commission is to advance business and other mutually beneficial activities between Oklahoma and Ireland. The Commission is to report any findings or recommendations to the Governor and legislative leadership within one year of its first meeting and by February 1 each year after.
