HB 3310 requires Service Oklahoma to send notice of motor vehicle registration renewal via United States mail, unless the individual specifically opts out of this mail notice.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3310 would require Service Oklahoma to send notice of motor vehicle registration renewal via U.S. mail, unless the individual specifically opts out of this mail notice. Currently, Service Oklahoma generates Three Million Eight Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-eight (3,893,588) registration notices per year. Of those, Six Hundred and Four Thousand Ninety-six (604,096) notices are sent via email. Assuming these individuals do not opt to email prior to their renewal period, the associated mailing costs are estimated to be Five Hundred Forty-three Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-six dollars and Forty cents (\$543,686.40) per year.

Additionally, Service Oklahoma estimates a one-time administrative cost of Fifteen Thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) to implement this measure.
