Research Analysis

HB 3315 modifies the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Act by:

- Defining *administrative support*;
- Changing the disbursement policy so that if the practitioner and second are not entitled to their share of the purse, the funds will move to the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Revolving Fund, rather than disbursed to the promoter;
- Declaring that the commission sets the salary of the administrative assistant, which is an unclassified position;
- Adding amateur kickboxing records to the list of records maintained by the Commission's administrative assistant;
- Reducing the maximum reimbursement to the State Department of Health for administrative support from 10 percent to five percent of the revenue from the preceding fiscal year; and
- Clarifying reimbursement procedures.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3315 grants authorization for funds withheld in the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Revolving Fund Security Account to be deposited into the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Revolving Fund if it is determined a combative sports practitioner is not entitled to their portion of money due to a violation of rules or regulations, thereby eliminating the mandate for the funds to be disbursed back to the promoter who staged the contest.

In addition, this measure decreases the reimbursement rate the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission pays the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) for providing administrative support to five percent (5%) of the total revenue from the previous fiscal year.

Officials from OSDH anticipate the fifty percent (50%) administrative support fee reduction to cost the agency eight thousand nine hundred thirty-two dollars and fourteen cents (\$8,932.14).

- Oklahoma State Athletic Commission Revenue FY-23: $\$178,642.88 \times 5\% = 8,932.14$
