## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3319 modifies requirements for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program. Specifically, this measure removes an educational activities exception for teen parents to qualify, and a supervised adult setting requirement for minor parents that have never married.

TANF is a federal block grant program that provides funds for states to assist low-income families. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services (DHS) will likely utilize available federal TANF funds to cover any estimated cost of this measure. No direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.
