Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to House Bill 3326 requires that drug abuse testing be directly observed by an employee or contractor of the opioid substitution treatment program for the first four tests, after which the testing must be directly observed by an employee or contractor of the opioid substitution treatment program at least once every third visit. If a patient fails a drug test, direct supervision is required for each test for the next six months.
