House Bill 3328, as introduced, requires any applicant for a Registered Nurse (RN) license, Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) license, Practical Nurse License (LPN), Advanced Unlicensed Assistant Certificate, multistate nursing license when Oklahoma is the Primary State of Residence, must submit and undergo a national criminal history background check.
