**Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendment to Engrossed HB3331 increases the administrative fines that the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission imposes for selling any tobacco product, nicotine product, or vapor product to another person who is under 21.

- Not more than \$250 for the first offense to both the employee and the store owner.
- Not more than \$500 for the second offense within a two-year period following the first offense to both the employee and the store owner.
- Not more than \$1,000 for a third offense within a two-year period following the first offense to both the employee and the store owner.
- 1,000 for a fourth or subsequent offense within a two-year period following the first offense to both the employee and the store owner.
