Research Analysis

HB 3350, as introduced, prohibits insurers from using towing or emergency road services as reason to cancel, refuse to renew, or increase the premium of an auto insurance policy. However, an insurer may take action on such coverage if, within 12 months, the insured files more than three claims for towing or emergency road services for one vehicle or more than five total claims for all covered vehicles.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3350 prohibits insurance companies from considering claims for towing services or emergency road services when underwriting an individual's policy for renewal unless the insured has filed more than three (3) of these claims for any one motor vehicle or more than five (5) claims collectively for all motor vehicles under one policy within a consecutive twelve-month period.

This measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriation.
