The committee substitute to House Bill 3371 expands the conditions of exemption from the Home Care Act for individuals who are employed by licensed home care agencies to provide personal care services in the home. These conditions include being supervised by a registered nurse at least once every six months and demonstrating competency in various caregiving tasks outlined in a written training plan developed by a registered nurse.
