Fiscal Analysis

HB 3382 creates the Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program to be administered by the State Department of Health (OSDH) to support research and care for those affected by ALS. The "Barbara Weber ALS Grant Program Revolving Fund" is established within this measure, allowing OSDH to retain ten percent (10%) of all deposited funds to cover administrative costs pertaining to the Program. Therefore, this measure is not anticipated to create a negative fiscal impact on the agency.

The measure creates a revolving fund, but does not provide funding for deposits. Thus, this measure has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.

The floor amendment does not affect the fiscal impact of this measure.
