Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to House Bill 3382 establishes the "Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program," administered by the Oklahoma State Department of Health. An annual report will be submitted to state officials detailing the grants awarded, recipient entities, and fund purposes. Additionally, a revolving fund named the "Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program Revolving Fund" is created in the Oklahoma State Treasury, comprising appropriations, donations, and other designated funding sources. This fund is intended for ALS research and program support, with the State Department of Health able to retain 10% of the funds for administrative costs.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3382 creates the Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program to be administered by the State Department of Health (OSDH) to support research and care for those affected by ALS. The "ALS Grant Program Revolving Fund" is established within this measure, allowing OSDH to retain ten percent (10%) of all deposited funds to cover administrative costs pertaining to the Program. Therefore, this measure is not anticipated to create a negative fiscal impact on the agency.

The measure creates a revolving fund, but does not provide funding for deposits. Thus, this measure has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
