**Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute to House Bill 3382 establishes the "Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program" administered by the State Department of Health. The program will fund ALS research and support programs for Oklahoma residents caring for family members with ALS. An annual report on grant distribution and usage will be submitted to state officials starting July 1, 2025. A revolving fund in the state treasury will finance the program, consisting of appropriations, donations, and grants.
