The proposed committee substitute to House Bill 3383 redefines "Covered services" as services reimbursed under the applicable subscriber agreement, notwithstanding and without regard to the contractual limitations on subscriber benefits.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3383 modifies the definition of *covered services* as it pertains to dental insurance claims made by a dentist or subscriber that was denied benefits based on lack of medical necessity. This measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriation.
