Research Analysis

HB 3386, as introduced, enables students to transfer to another school within the same district at any time of the year, except when the receiving school is already full for that grade level. The district board of education must establish a policy to determine the capacity of intra-district transfer students and include preferences for students residing in the school site boundary, those who attended the school the previous year, and siblings of current students. The policy may also include reasons for denial due to a history of suspensions or unexcused absences. The board will establish capacity quarterly to be subsequently published online and reported to the State Department of Education.
