**Research Analysis**

HB 3404, as introduced, authorizes the unused funds from the \$50 million annually allocated to school districts through the School Security Revolving Fund to be used as grants for additional security enhancements. Grants of up to \$10,000 will be awarded by the State Department of Education to districts in order of application.
