HB 3457, as introduced, alters tuition reimbursement rates for concurrent enrollment. Tuition will be reimbursed at up to \$120 per credit hour in the 2025 fiscal year. The reimbursement rate will be adjusted to reflect percentage changes in the Consumer Price Index every subsequent year.
