**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute for HB 3508 transfers the Employee Group Insurance Division from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

**CHANGES IN FLOOR SUBSTITUTE FROM INTRODUCED:**

The floor substitute transfers the division to the Health Care Authority instead of the Public Employee Retirement System.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 3508 transfers the administration of the Employee Group Insurance Division (EGID) from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA). As written, OMES does not foresee any significant fiscal impact to the self-insured plans, but the agency does note that specific costs and/or efficiencies related to this administrative transfer are unknown at this time. OCHA states there may be additional administrative, technology, or building costs associated with this transfer, but those are expected to be minimal as long as all EGID-related resources are transferred over to the agency.
