Research Analysis

HB 3509, as introduced, updates the official system of coordinates used throughout the state by adding the Oklahoma Plane Coordinate System (OKPCS) to the list of coordinate systems used to define geographic positions or point locations. The OKPCS is the most recent coordinate system established by the National Geodetic Survey. The measure also repeals <u>Title 60 Section 1006</u>, which relates to limitations on recording coordinates.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3509 updates references to the most up-to-date plane coordinate system as established by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)/National Geodetic Survey (NGS) as well as repeals a section of statute related to a limitation on recording certain coordinates.
