Honoring Certain Individuals Killed In Performance of Duties: \$1,720 per Designation

Research Analysis

HB 3516 memorializes several highways, bridges, and interchanges across Oklahoma and modifies the location descriptions and names of certain memorialized highways and bridges.

New designations include the:

- C.B. and Lois Craft Memorial Bridge in Haskell County;
- SFC Theodore Emmett Lowery Memorial Highway in Muskogee County;
- LCpl Charles Nick Bondi Memorial Highway in Oklahoma County;
- Nettie Sands Memorial Bridge in Leflore County;
- Dale McFarlin Memorial Highway in Lincoln County;
- Dr. Harry E. Heath, Jr. Memorial Bridge in Payne County;
- Ryan Gwaltney Memorial Bridge in Comanche County;
- U.S. Army SGT William A. Fox, Jr. Memorial Bridge in Pittsburg County;
- SSG Rusty Dunagan Memorial Bridge in McClain County;
- Cpl Mick Ray Bekowsky USMC Memorial Interchange in Oklahoma County; and
- LCpl Anthony D. Botello Memorial Bridge in Latimer County.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3516 designates eleven (11) new memorial highway and bridge locations in Oklahoma, as well as amends three (3) current designations in statute. Title 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, peace officers, and first responders who were killed in the performance of their duties.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) currently estimates a cost of one thousand seven hundred and twenty dollars (\$1,720.00) per location that meets these qualifications, with one sign needed at each end of the designated highway or bridge.
