Research Analysis

HB 3517 modifies the name of the Shriners Hospitals for Children license plate, Rotary Club of Oklahoma license plate, the Frederick A. Douglass High School license plate, the South Central Section of the PGA Foundation license plate, and the Red Dirt Jeep license plate to conform with a duplicate sections issue. The Hallett Motor Racing Circuit license plate, Tulsa Icon license plate and ROAD license plate are modified to include the use of personalized plates and the use of such plates on motorcycles.

The measure repeals a duplicate version of [47 O.S. Section 1135.3](#) to address a duplicate sections issue.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3517 expands three specialty license plates to be applicable for a motorcycle license plate as well as creates the ORA specialty license plate to be created and distributed by Service Oklahoma. Per statute, the annual fee for this license plate will be Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per year. Eight dollars (\$8.00) of this fee will be deposited in the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement Fund and the remaining Seven dollars (\$7.00) will be apportioned as provided in Title 47 Section 1104 of the Oklahoma Statutes. In total, Service Oklahoma estimates an implementation cost of Fifteen Thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) to update registration and renewal transactions as well as to update the new special plates and plate types. It is expected that Service Oklahoma would absorb this cost within current budgetary resources.
