**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3531 creates the Early Childhood Task Force (Task Force), comprised of nineteen (19) voluntarily serving members, none of which are to be compensated or reimbursed for any expenses. However, officers or employees of state agencies who are appointed to the Task Force as part of their duties shall be authorized to participate on the Task Force and may claim subsistence, allowance, mileage, or associated expenses from their respective agency budgets as permitted by law (e.g., State Travel Reimbursement Act). All costs are expected to be minimal and absorbed within existing budgetary resources at applicable agencies.
