**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee amendment for HB3567 makes numerous changes from the previous version to include allowing practitioners to be excluded from electronic prescription requirements to prescribe a controlled substance that will be consumed within 72 hours or if an electronic prescription isn't possible and the patient is at risk. It further clarifies that official prescription forms are approved, not provided by OSBNN.

The provision that practitioners are registered without charge for a total of two years is removed
