Research Analysis

HB3567, as introduced, allows electronic prescriptions to be used for compounded prescriptions, compounded infusion prescriptions, and prescriptions issued under approved research protocols and requires that all written prescriptions use official forms from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, purchased by the medical provider, and sourced from approved vendors. These forms can include multiple addresses but are only for the registered practitioner's use.

The bill adds and alphabetizes definitions, allows the Director to issue orders for violations, with their order becoming final if no individual proceeding is requested, and requires registrants facing action to maintain registration and renew annually.
