Research Analysis

HB3575, as introduced, clarifies that the Attorney General may bring a civil action on behalf of any governmental or public entity that is indirectly or directly affected by a violation of the Oklahoma Antitrust Reform Act and clarifies the statutes of limitation for a cause of action. For every successful action, the court must consider a series a factors to determine the civil penalty, which may be up to \$1 million per violation of the act.
