**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3591 requires that certain persons over the age of 18 receive an official or certified copy of their United States birth certificate, a Social Security card, information on how to obtain their medical records and health insurance, and a state-issued identification card or driver's license upon custodial release from the Oklahoma Office of Juvenile Affairs. The committee substitute does not alter the fiscal impact of the measure.
