Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3595 directs the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC) to establish an online jobs center for employers to post job openings. Claimants seeking unemployment benefits are required to take a skills test, create an account, and add a resume on the online platform. Claimants must apply to the minimum number of jobs as determined by OESC. Failure to apply or participate will result in the termination of benefits for a full period of unemployment. Additionally, OESC must verify the eligibility of claims filed and may cross-check various state and national databases to verify eligibility.
