Research Analysis

HB 3596, as introduced, increases the percentages of the state's average annual wage that will be applied for taxes based on certain conditions during a calendar year. The measure allows the extended duration of continued unemployment insurance claims to remain in effect until the end of the year. The measure also alters certain benefit amounts excludes severance pay and one-time federal benefits from the definition of wages and removes the requirement for documents to be hand-delivered to OESC when filed.

Additionally, the measure repeals [40 O.S. Section 3-201](#), which refers to Employer for Any Part of Year Deemed Employer for Entire Year.
