HB3597, as introduced, designates the Secretary of Workforce Development and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission as the new coordinator of the Governor's Council on Workforce and Economic Development. Those duties are currently the responsibility of the Secretary of Commerce and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The measure also removes the ODOC director from council membership.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure removes some duties around the Governor's Council for Workforce and Economic Development (Council) from the Department of Commerce to the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC). OESC is traditionally a non-appropriated agency and was, by statute, already involved with the Council. Given OESC's status, there should be no fiscal impact to the state budget.
