The Committee Substitute to HB 3613 establishes a 5 day time limitation for the filing of an indictment or information after the arrest of a person. The State may extend the 5 day period upon a showing of good cause. The arrested person may seek release on their own recognizance upon the expiration of the 5 day period if no information or indictment has been filed.
