Fiscal Analysis

This measure provides for alternate membership on the Pardon and Parole Board (PPB) in certain clemency hearings. The cost to the PPB would be \$574 per affected clemency hearing based on 57 O.S. § 4(A)(1) plus the cost of lodging and/or per diem rates set by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES). HB3633 also creates exposure to potential litigation if inmates attempt to force a Board member's recusal in favor of one of the legislatively appointed alternates. Utilization of this is likely to be rare, thus the impact is expected to be minimal and the PPB is likely to absorb any related costs by using existing budgetary resources.

Therefore, in its current form, HB3633 is not anticipated to have a negative impact on state budget or appropriations.
