Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB3643 removes the requirement that the State Records Administrator approve the destruction of nonrecord materials and other state agency records that are not regulated by the Records Management Act.

The measure also updates numerous references related to records management, clarifies that records will be stored in a secure location instead of maximum security vault and repeals the following statute related to microfiling:

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3643 clarifies that the destruction of records that are not regulated by the Records Management Act may be destroyed without the approval of the State Records Administrator.
