**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3644 requires special agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, or the Internal Revenue Service who are conducting a raid or warrantless arrest of a citizen of Oklahoma to make contact with the sheriff of the county in which the raid or arrest is taking place. The special agent is to inform the sheriff of the approximate date, time, and circumstances of the raid or warrantless arrest.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3644 requires federal special agents to contact and provide certain information to the county sheriff in which the warrantless arrest or raid will take place prior to the operation. This measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriation.
