Research Analysis

HB 3671 allows a person to voluntarily designate on their driver license or identification card that the person has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder. Service Oklahoma is to establish and maintain an automated statewide registry accessible by law enforcement officers for the purposes of identifying and effectively communicating with a person who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder. The Department of Public Safety, in consultation with Service Oklahoma, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training, and the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, is to develop a program to assist and train law enforcement officers to identify and effectively communicate with a person who has been diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder.
