**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute to HB 3686 prohibits any person from setting up unauthorized camps on state-owned lands. An *unauthorized camp* is defined in the measure as any tent, shelter, or bedding constructed for overnight sleeping on property not designated as a campsite. Violators are subject to a \$50 fine or up to 15 days in the county jail or both if convicted. A first offense will result in a warning and the arresting officer may not issue a citation unless the violator refuses assistance such as transportation to a shelter or food pantry, or other available indigent resources.
