**Research Analysis**

CCR A for HB 3693 modifies the appointment specifications of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. The Governor appoints five members, one from each of the five congressional districts. The remaining four members are at-large, required to be from Oklahoma and experienced in horse racing; two are appointed by the House Speaker and two are appointed by the Senate Pro Tem. In the case of a vacancy, the legislative leaders alternate appointments, beginning with the Speaker.

The measure also amends the requirements for expenditures from the Oklahoma Breeding Development Fund Special Account so that, in the case of providing funding for a nonprofit that cares for retired and unwanted Oklahoma-bred race horses, available federal funds must be used, rather than the Horse Racing Commission's special account.
