**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3696 provides that any person who, without justifiable or excusable cause, commits during the commission of a crime, a battery or an assault and battery upon an employee of the retail establishment while such employee is in the performance of his or her duties is guilty of a felony, punishable by up to 2 years in prison, a fine of up to \$2,500 or both fined and imprisonment.
