**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3719 modifies the procedures for determining jurisdiction and venue for multicounty grand juries. The measure provides that in the event the Attorney General elects to prosecute an indictment or accusation for removal, the action may be prosecuted in any county in which jurisdiction and venue are otherwise appropriate. If not prosecuted by the AG, but referred to another prosecuting authority, the county of the residence of the defendant is to be the venue.
