Research Analysis

The PCS1 to HB 3729 modifies the expungement process by allowing for the automatic expungement of nonviolent misdemeanor criminal arrest records expunged. The measure provides that any person who was convicted of a nonviolent misdemeanor offense, at least ten years have passed since the date of conviction, the person has not been convicted of a felony, all fines, fees, and restitution if ordered by the court have been paid, and no felony or misdemeanor charges are pending against the person, shall have his or her nonviolent misdemeanor criminal arrest records automatically expunged.
