**Research Analysis**

HB3747, as introduced, permits the Oklahoma Veterans Commission to contract with private nursing facilities to offer services to eligible veterans living over 50 miles from a State Veterans Home.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3747 allows the Oklahoma Veterans Commission to enter into contracts with private nursing facilities to provide services to Oklahoma Veterans who reside more than fifty (50) miles from a State Veterans Home. Furthermore, upon admission, if an Oklahoma Veteran resides more than fifty (50) miles from a State Veteran Home, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) is directed to pay for a bed at a long-term care nursing facility within fifty (50) miles of the Oklahoma Veteran's residence.

ODVA has been contacted regarding potential fiscal implications on the agency. As ODVA provides feedback to potential costs this impact will be updated.
