The FA1 to HB 3757 modifies the procedure for obtaining a waiver from the Oklahoma Jail Standards Act. The FA1 removes the ability of the detention facility administrator from declaring a temporary emergency.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure would create new responsibilities for the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) related to the inspection of certain correctional facilities.
