Research Analysis

House Bill 3760, as introduced, adds "Medication Preparation" to the list of defined terms in the Nursing Home Care Act. Authorizing a licensed nurse, operating within the boundaries of their licensure as defined by the Oklahoma Board of Nursing, to prepare medications for administration, including the reconstitution of such medications.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3760 defines "Medication preparation" as used in the Nursing Home Care Act, which allows a licensed nurse performing duties within the scope of their licensure to prepare medications for administration. This measure is not expected to directly impact the state budget or appropriations.
