**Research Analysis**

HB 3762, as introduced, allows counties that participate in a multi-county library system to request a review of the library system's overall budget and estimate of need if approved by 2/3 vote of all participating boards of county commissioners. The measure designates the executive director or the employee in charge of accounting to produce the requested information. Additionally, the measure provides that the review location must be either agreed upon by all boards of county commissioners or be based on the county that contributes the most funding.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3762 provides codification for the permissive adoption of certain procedures regarding multi-county library systems. This measure is fundamentally procedural, and allows for the adoption of methods relating to accounting requests, designations, and presentations. Therefore, this measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
