Fiscal Analysis

This measure increases the county population requirement to establish a County Public Defender office from 300,000 people to 600,000 people based on the 2020 Federal Decennial Census. In consultation with officials from Oklahoma Indigent Defense Systems (OIDS), HB3765 would ensure that OIDS continues to provide trial services to the counties which they already serve, thereby maintaining their budgetary status quo.

Therefore, in its current form, HB3765 is not anticipated to have an impact on state budget or appropriations.
