## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB3778 creates the Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act and is a uniform law developed by the Uniform Law Commission. The act creates a framework to govern access to a person's online accounts when the account owner dies or loses the ability to manage the account. The acts provides that an account owners may use an online tool to direct the custodian of the account to disclose some or all of the users digital assets to a named fiduciary. If the person did not use a online tool to name a fiduciary, the owners can grant access to a fiduciary by will, trust, power of attorney or another instrument conveying access.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

This measure creates the Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act, providing provisions and procedures for when certain online accounts can no longer be managed by the account's owner. In its current form, HB3778 is not anticipated to have an impact on state budget or appropriations.
