The CS to HB 3782 provides that there is to be a rebuttable presumption that no conditions of release on bond would assure the safety of the community or any person therein if the state shows by clear and convincing evidence that the person was arrested for a violent offense and was released on bond or if the person commits a crime listed as a violent crimes while out on bond.
