HB 3784 adds assault, battery, or assault and battery upon an intimate partner or a family or household member with a sharp, dangerous, or deadly weapon to the list of crimes for which a person is required to serve 85% of the sentence imposed.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure adds assault, battery, or assault and battery upon an intimate partner or a family or household member with a sharp, dangerous, or deadly weapon to the list of crimes for which a person is required to serve 85% of the sentence imposed. In consultation with officials from the Department of Corrections (DOC), cost analysis for this measure is as follows:

Receptions for O.S. 21-644(D)(1) have increased over a 10 year span. Receptions for O.S. 21-644(D)(2) have only occurred since 2022 and there are no releases as of yet.

*Individuals sentenced to Domestic violence crimes are entered into an overall Domestic Violence category in sentencing. Determining the type of domestic violence is a free text field that can't be easily quarried, therefore Num of Inmates provided is conservative.

Based on available sentencing data for O.S. 21-644(D)(1), multiplying the 5.54 year increase in time served for this crime by the \$6,811.85 FY23 Annual Cost of Incarceration results in a \$37,752.12 projected cost increase for one inmate serving the increased sentence length. For the 113 inmates currently incarcerated for this crime, there would be a projected aggregate cost increase of \$4,265,989.18. Because the average time served for O.S. 21-644(D)(2) is unknown, if an inmate must serve at least 85% of the average sentence then a conservative total cost estimate for one inmate is \$78,744.90.

Given increasing reception for these crimes, unavailable data for O.S. 21-644(D)(2), and limitations on current sentencing data, there is a minimum aggregate cost increase to the DOC of \$4,265,989.18 for the increased sentence lengths pursuant to HB3784.
