Fiscal Analysis

According the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC), this measure will require ODWC to hire at least one in-house attorney. ODWC estimates the cost of salary and benefits to be Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00). Traditionally, ODWC is a non-appropriated state agency, but it did submit a budget request for Fiscal Year 2025. Given this information, if ODWC cannot absorb the costs, the impact to the state budget would be \$60,000 per year.
